Some of the journals require your StFX account information to view the contents and have the note **StFX only**. The remaining journals are Open Access with no login required.

Click on a journal title to view the contents. If the journal is **StFX only**, you will see a blue login box to the StFX “Proxy Server”. Type your StFX username and password. It is the same login information you use for Moodle. You will then be redirected to the journal homepage and can browse or search the content.
